From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Father, I was wondering... how should I examine my conscience? (cont) Dear Friend, thank you for your great question. Lent is a perfect time to examine our conscience to uncover our sins and weaknesses and work on eliminating them. Ask ourselves... Do I use impure or suggetive words? Do I tell impure stories, or listen to them? Do I look at impure television, internet, plays, email, or movies? Do I read impure material? Do I perform impure acts by myself, or with another person? Did I marry outside of the church? Have I violated my marriage vows? Have I been inappropriate with another person's spouse? Have I practiced artificial birth control, or have I been artificially sterilized? Did I cheat, steal, or help another person to do so? Have I kept stolen goods? Have I made restitution for what I have stolen? Have I failed to fulfill my comitments, or failed to pay my bills, or did I give or accept bribes? Did I gamble excesibly? Did I deprive my family? Did I tell lies? Did I injure or deceive anyone? Have I comitted perjury? Have I voted in accord with a properly informed conscience, and in a way that is consistent with the teachings of the Church?
